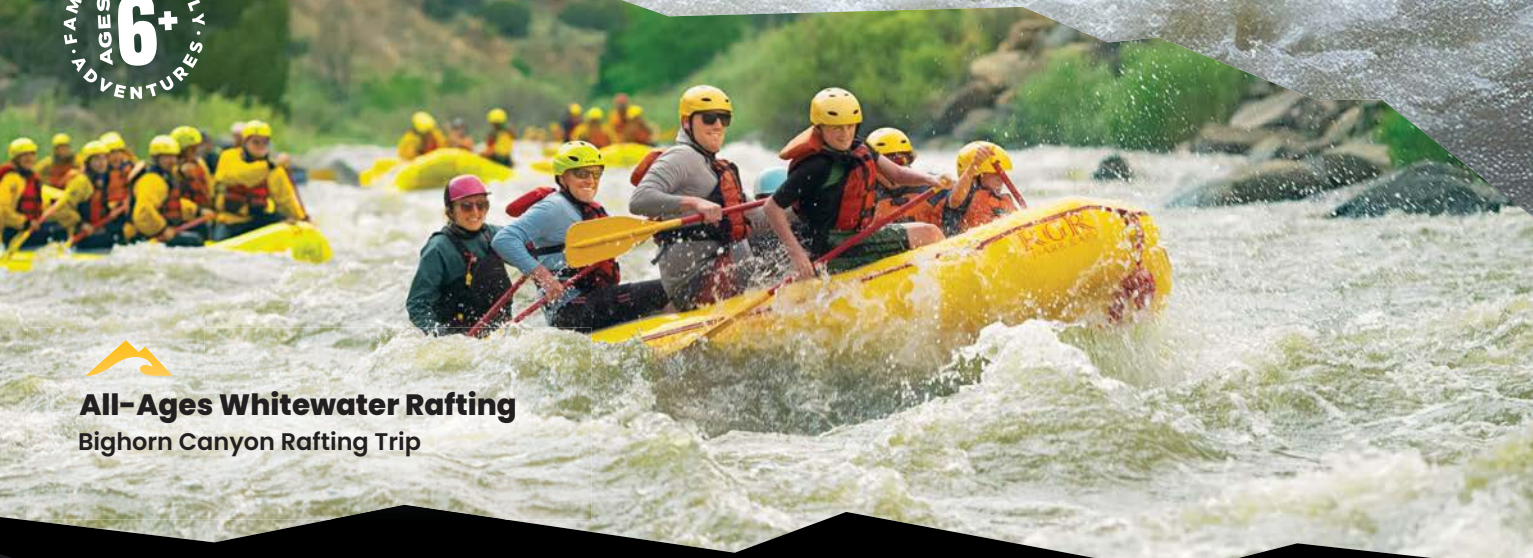

SALT THERAPY (HALOTHERAPY)

One of the most popular experiences at the center is salt therapy. Guests relax inside a Himalayan salt cave while microscopic salt particles are dispersed into the air helping boost respiratory function.

The space is quiet and calming, making it an easy way to unwind after a busy day. Many visitors include it as a simple break between activities while exploring the region.

RED LIGHT THERAPY

Red light therapy is a convenient option for those with limited time. Sessions are short and often chosen as a way to support relaxation and recovery.

This combination is especially popular with visitors who have spent the day hiking or staying active.

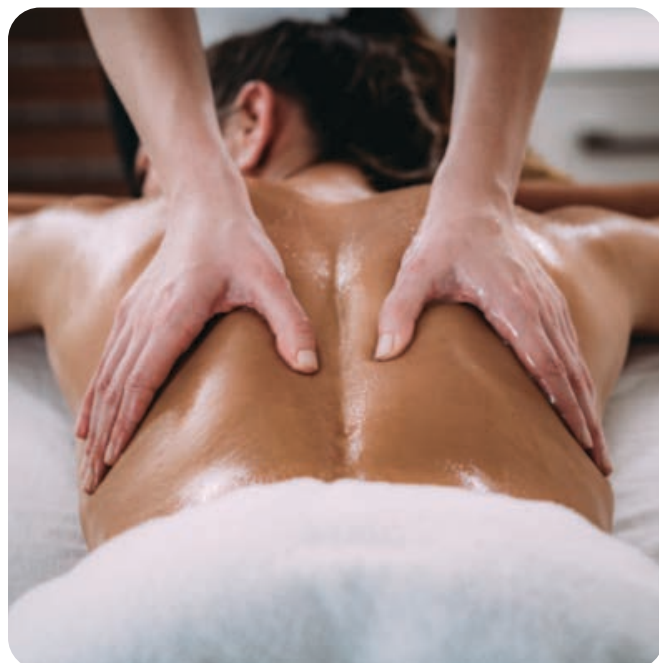
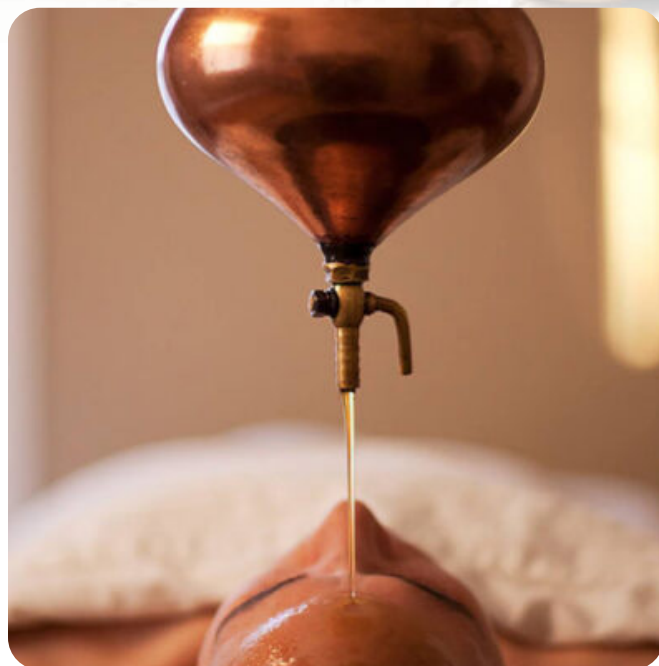
MASSAGE AND OTHER THERAPIES

Pikes Peak is the manifestation of the American spirit and the desire to explore and experience our vast frontier. It is an extraordinary place to visit, almost the only place in the world where people of all ages and abilities can experience the summit of a 14,000-foot peak.

This is the setting for the new Pikes Peak Summit Visitor Center, a new building designed to enhance the experience of reaching the top. The facility's careful placement and sensitive design puts the focus on the stunning landscape, allowing boundless sky and view to take center stage.



No matter how visitors get to the top – by driving the 19-mile scenic Pikes Peak Highway, hiking one of the high-altitude trails or riding the cog railway – the reinvigorated summit experience offers the chance to learn more about America's Mountain's people, place, and the Peak today. New interpretive exhibits share facts about the mountain's history, climate, geography, events, and conservation



initiatives. The new indoor exhibit gallery includes an interactive digital experience that allows visitors from across the world to weave their own personal experience into the mountain's story. and key guest supported sustainability features include a water refill station, recycling bins, high efficiency fixtures, and environmentally friendly packaging and products.

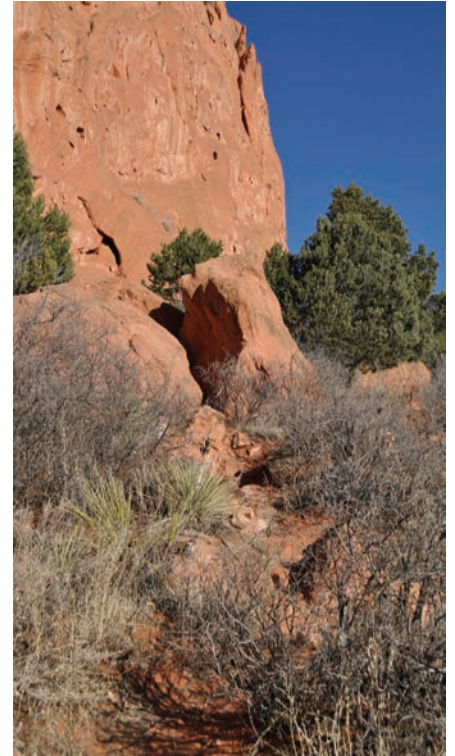
The Park is Free to the Public

In 1859, Rufus Cable and M.S. Beach, two surveyors from Denver City were assigned to locate and layout a townsite for a boom town, soon to be called Colorado City. While searching for the town's ideal location, they came across an awe inspiring area of sandstone formations. M.S. Beach, who related the incident, suggested that it would be a "capital place for a beer garden" when the country grew up. Rufus Cable, "a young and poetic man", exclaimed a "Beer Garden! Why this is a fit place for the Gods to assemble. We will call it the Garden of the Gods!" The Beer Garden never materialized but the name remains today.


This natural treasure was given to the City of Colorado Springs in 1909 by the children of railroad magnate Charles Elliot Perkins honoring his wish that the Park remain free for the public to enjoy. In 1971, Garden of the Gods became a Registered National Natural Landmark.

Garden of the Gods Parks offers something for everyone. Take pleasure in the spectacular red rock formations and the views of Pikes Peak as you hike along fifteen miles of trails, take a guided nature walk, go mountain biking or technical rock climbing (permits and appropriate climbing gear required) or just enjoy a picnic with someone special.

This park is also a paradise for




photographers, professional and amateur alike. There are spectacular settings around every corner. Look for two of the most well known formations-the Kissing Camels and Balanced Rock.


The park is free and open to the public year-around daily at 5 a.m. Travel through billions of years in less than 15 minutes and learn how the amazing red rocks got there with the Geo-Trekker Movie Experience at the Visitor and Nature Center.

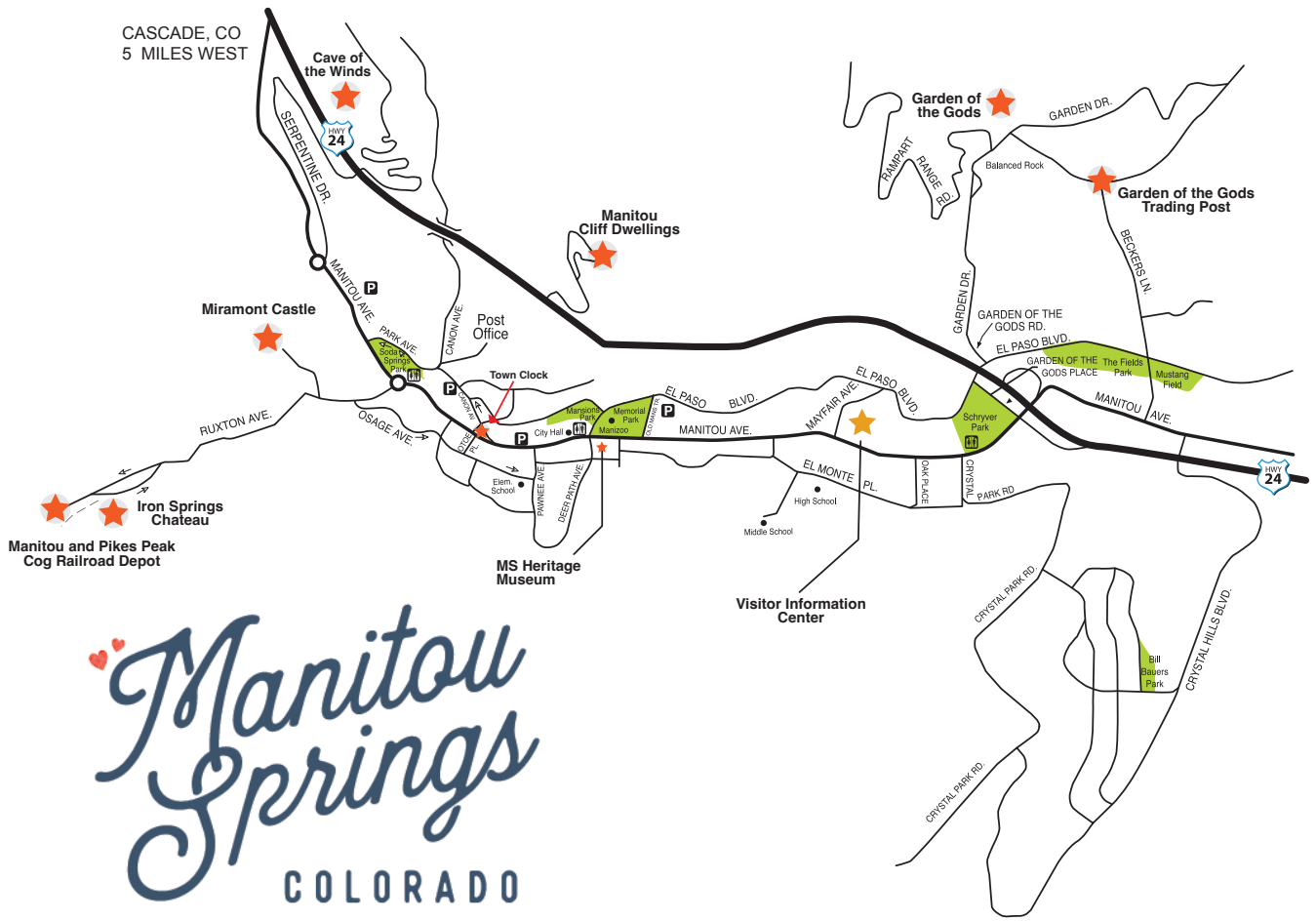

Manitou Cliff Dwellings

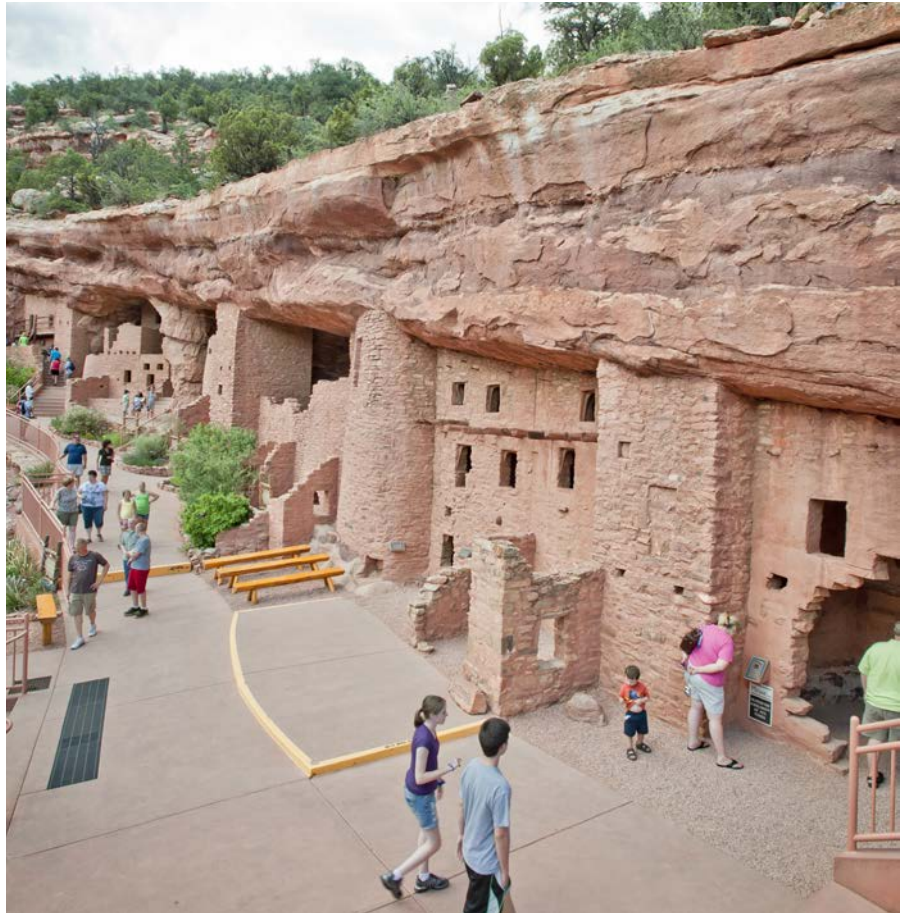
See the Magic and Mystery of Ancient Native American Culture

The Manitou Cliff Dwellings, located in Manitou Springs, is a rare historical treasure. Experience the architecture of the Ancestral Puebloans. Preserved under a red sandstone overhang these cliff dwellings were relocated and reconstructed from the Four Corners area, and opened to the public in 1907.



There are no "Do Not Touch" signs. You are free to touch and explore around inside these fascinating architectural remnants. The Ancestral Puebloans roamed the Four Corners area from 1200 B.C to 1300 A.D. and are believed to have migrated after a 29-year drought.

Next to the cliff dwellings is a three-story Pueblo building that today houses the museums and a stunning gift shop, offering many Colorado and Native American made treasures. Multiple museums allow you to discover a variety of tools, pottery and ways of life. Check out the retro nostalgic souvenir collection alongside a pictorial display of the first 100 years of the Manitou Cliff Dwellings. The original structure, dating back to the turn of the 20th century, was built by and housed



generations of Puebloans, and was expanded in the 1990's.

The outdoor archeological and natural history preserve includes reproductions of a stone mesa-top building, a horno oven, and specialized gardens. The location overlooks the beautiful valley of Manitou Springs and features a wonderful view of Pikes Peak. Roam through the tranquil dwellings and study the native gardens abundant edible and me-

dicinal uses.

Explore with a trip into America's past, and plan to visit the Manitou Cliff Dwellings soon. Discovering the magic and mystery of what happened to the ancient cliff dweller culture in this spectacular setting is sure to delight visitors of all ages. The dwellings are open year-round, except for Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day, weather permitting.

We invite you to step back in time at Miramont Castle Museum, with breathtaking beauty in the Castle Gardens, fascinating history inside the museum, and delicious dining in the Queen's Parlour Tea Room with our modern take on traditional Victorian tea service.

Since 1976, the Manitou Springs Historical Society has thoughtfully and carefully restored Miramont Castle, room by room. Our most recent renovations include the Great Hall, completed in November 2022, and the Formal Dining Room, completed in 2024.

The first floor of Miramont Castle Museum offers an impressive exhibit of the Manitou Springs Volunteer Fire Department, with fascinating displays showing the history of firefighting. You

can even try on a real firefighter's hat and jacket!

Miramont Castle is currently updating the 'Spoils of War' and 'Nürnberg Trials' exhibits, which contain American, German and Japanese military artifacts, and fascinating details surrounding the famous Nürnberg Trials (spelling later changed to 'Nuremberg').

In 2024, Miramont Castle opened its newest exhibit, 'Adolph Bandelier: Southwest Retrospective,' featuring beautifully curated photographs and maps of Bandelier's travels throughout

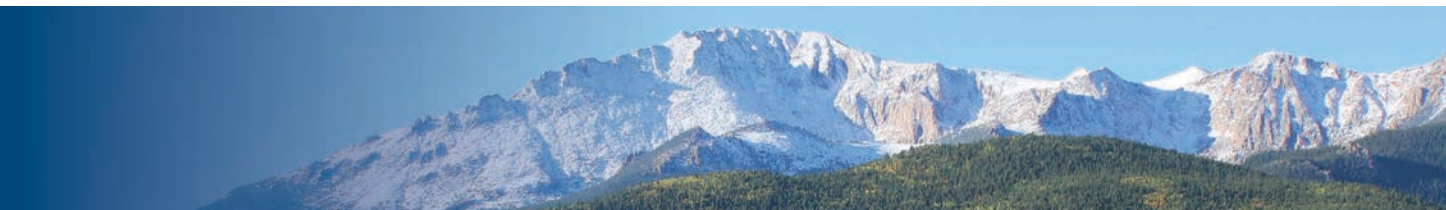

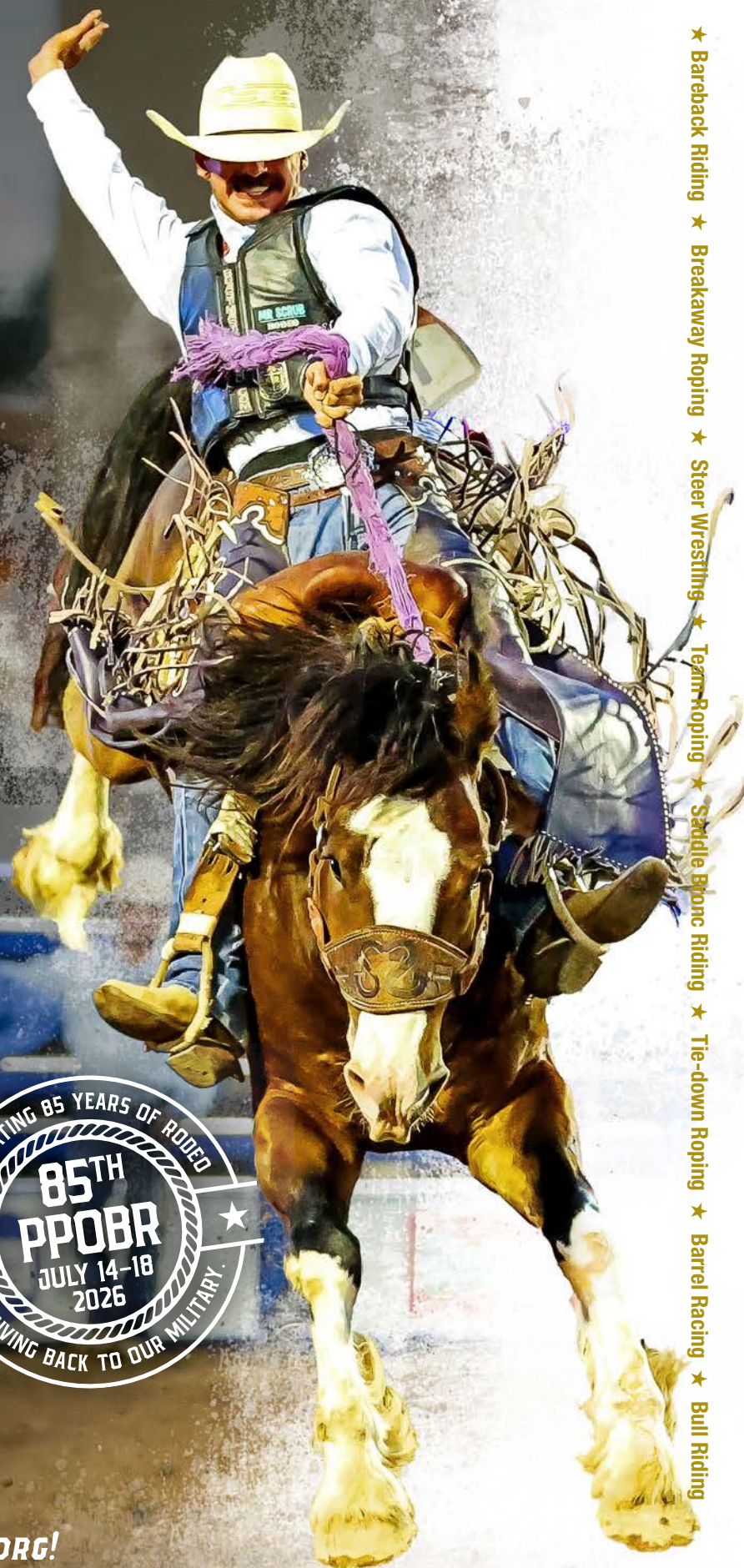

How to Host a Beer Dinner

Like any gastronomic experience, the proper setting and preparation can mean the difference between an ordinary experience and a fabulous one. Here are a few things to consider when enjoying American craft beer and food.

Taste from less to more intense. Alcohol, hops, roast malt and sweetness can tire your palate, so it's wise to put the more delicate beers at the start of the tasting.

Glassware matters. Proper glassware shows off the color, supports the head, and focuses the aroma of beer for the best possible tasting experience. All classic European beer styles have a traditional glass, and American versions usually work well in those. Whatever the glass, make sure it is spotlessly clean. Stronger beers should be served in smaller portions.

Observe proper serving temperatures. Each beer tastes best at certain temperature. Serving a beer too cold masks a lot of flavor and aroma. Served too warm, beer loses its wonderful refreshing quality.

Control the setting. There are many different types of tasting experiences, from formal judging to casual drinking. In all instances, providing a comfortable environment free from distractions will enhance the experience and show off the beers at their best. Light, noise, smoke, room temperature and many other things need to be considered.

Don't overdo it. Whether in a beer tasting or a dinner, tasting too many beers can lead to palate overload. Try to limit the number of beers to six to eight tasting portions. Beer contains alcohol, so please enjoy responsibly

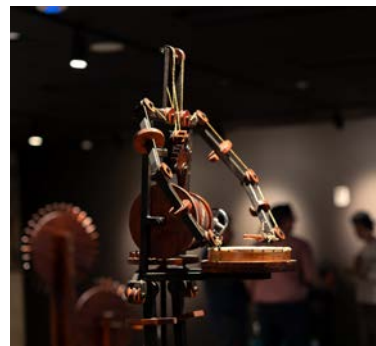

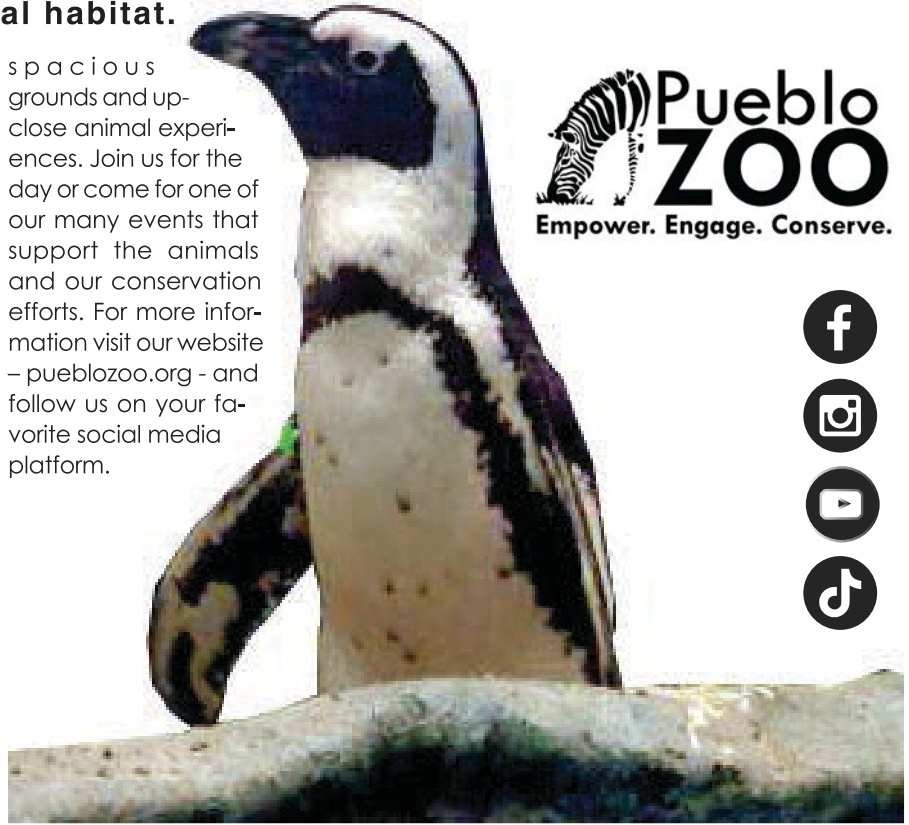
PUEBLO ZOO

The Pueblo Zoo is an Association of Zoos and Aquariums (AZA) accredited facility covering twenty-five acres in Pueblo City Park. It is home to more than 200 animals representing 125 different species from around the world. Managed by the non-profit Pueblo Zoological Society, the Pueblo Zoo works diligently to delight guests while achieving a conservation mission, supporting many local projects, as well as global conservation efforts through our Quarters for Conservation program. The City of Pueblo has maintained a zoo in some form since the early 1900s. The current site in City Park is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The current Islands of Life and World of Color buildings, as well as the eagle exhibits, were constructed in the 1930s by the PWA and WPA. Guests can see the influence of this notable architectural style throughout the zoo.

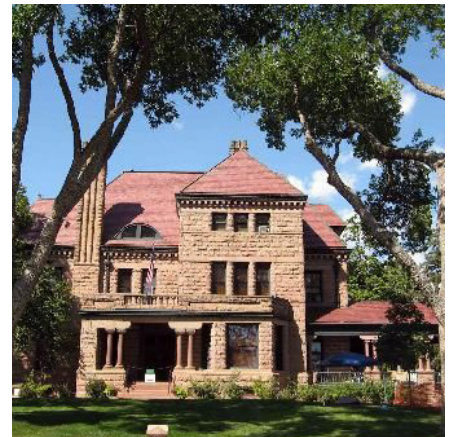

Lured by the adventure and opportunity of the West, John Thatcher moved from Pennsylvania to Colorado where he became a successful merchant and banker, with interests in mining, cattle ranching and agriculture. His considerable fortune enabled him to build Rosemount at a time when many structures in the still pioneer town were adobe and many streets yet unpaved.

Rosemount features an amazing 85 percent originality with the house virtually unchanged through three-quarters of a century while family members lived in the home. Nearly all furnishings, wall and window treatments, decorative arts and paintings, and household items are original. The 37-room, 24,000 square-foot mansion is adorned with beautiful oak, cherry, mahogany and maple woodwork.

Plan to visit Colorado's Crown Jewel. See where the fashionable East met the rugged American West at the end of the 19th century.

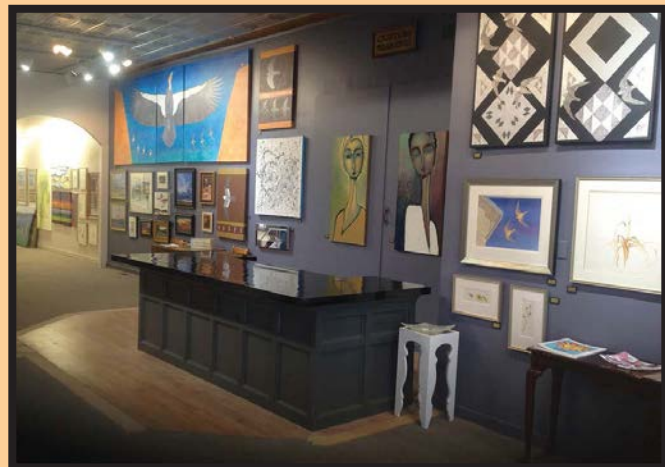

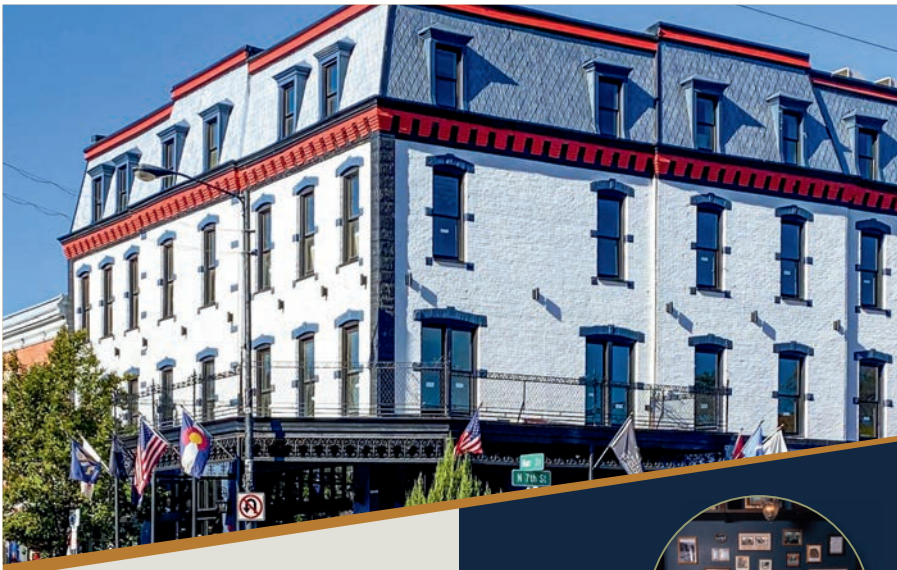

This two-story building has two dining/hang-out areas, including the stunning wooden pergola on the bottom level. The 1,500-square-foot rooftop patio overlooks the Arkansas River, Centennial Park, and the mountains that ring Cañon City.

MUSEUM of COLORADO PRISONS

Cañon City, Colorado is home to the museum of Colorado Prisons, a show-case of atmosphere and exhibits of days, employees and inmates gone by. A visit to the Royal Gorge Region isn't complete without stopping by and "doing time" in this historical cell house that was once the original Women's Correctional Facility, constructed in 1935.

The remodeled facility now welcomes an exploration of the history of Colorado corrections. Individual MP3 audio tours guide visitors through 32 cells filled with exciting exhibits and life-sized models, each with their own story to tell, linking the past to the present in dramatic presentation. Other artifacts and exhibits include:



- The hangman's noose used for the last execution by hanging in Colorado
- Confiscated inmate weapons and contraband
- The last gas chamber
- Rare, historic photographs depicting life in prison facilities
- Displays of disciplinary paraphernalia used from 1871 to the present
- Federal Bureau of Prisons display
- Inmate Arts and Crafts
- Gift Shop
- And much more!

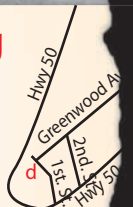

Welcome to Cripple Creek, a historic gaming and mining town where gold has flowed out of the hills for over 135 years.

Gold flows today from the Newmont Corporation mine, covering over seven square miles, where 30 million year old rocks that formed from magma, erupted and intruded through rocks that are over one billion years old. Over 4 million ounces of gold have been recovered from the area to date.

Gold also flows from the ten casinos that occupy the downtown district where you can gamble and play 24/7 in the modern gaming halls, many located within the walls of historic buildings. Games range from state-of-the-art slot machines, to casino and video poker, roulette, blackjack, craps, dice games and sports betting.

Cripple Creek is full of history for the entire family. The Mollie Kathleen Gold Mine allows you to travel back in time descending down 1,000 feet of solid rock into the historic gold mines themselves. The Old Homestead House Museum offers a glimpse back to the golden era of 1896 brothels in the mining town. Madam Pearl De-Vere is honored each year during a special event held in her honor.

Cripple Creek's famous donkey herd has wandered the streets of town since they were turned loose by miners to roam the hillsides in the late 1920s. The Two Mile High Club was formed in 1931 to care for the donkeys. Donations from local businesses, memberships, individuals and grants cover the costs for vet care, shelter

and food. The donkeys make their big appearance from winter grazing pastures Memorial Day weekend each year. Donkey Derby Days is the main fundraising event, occurring in June each summer.

Many of the businesses in town are housed in 1896 historic buildings. A good example is the Rocky Mountain Canary General Store, opened in 1972. The building was a blacksmith shop for over 40 years. Now it's full of everything from ice cream to fur coats!

The Butte Theater is another classic in the town of Cripple Creek. Located in a beautifully renovated facility owned and operated by the City, melodramas, plays and skits are performed by professional and amateur performers year round.

Overlooking the town of Cripple Creek, the 11,600 square foot Cripple Creek Heritage Center was built in 2007. Exhibits in the building feature geology, flora and fauna, history of mining, railroads, brothels, Native Americans, flowery characters of Cripple Creek's past and even dinosaurs!

Other major events in town include the annual Ice Fest in February, rodeos, art and car shows, concerts, fireworks, history talks, military appreciation, Victorian tours, and much more.

Cripple Creek & Victor Narrow Gauge Railroad

The NFR Open at the Pikes Peak or Bust Rodeo is where the top professional rodeo cowboys and cowgirls in the U.S., Canada and Mexico compete to be named PRCA Circuit Champions. There's bragging rights in play and mega prize money to win. Watching PRORODEO live and in person is like no other pro sport experience. Come to Colorado Springs, Colorado July 14-18—this is where you belong!

During the late 1890s, better transportation was needed to access the gold mines in the Cripple Creek and Victor area. Lines were created from Cripple Creek to Victor, Colorado Springs and Florence to transport not only gold ore to the reduction mills in Colorado Springs, but people and freight including explosives, machinery, lumber, coal and food.

From the southern direction, the Florence and Cripple Creek Railroad was a 3 ft. narrow-gauge railroad following the route up the steep and narrow Phantom Canyon. That route can be driven today between Victor and Florence, but only



for the brave of heart! This road is part of the Gold Belt Byway, open for traffic most of the summer months.

In 1967, Dr. John Birmingham opened the Cripple Creek and Victor Narrow Gauge Railroad. A family business, CC&V RR has been touring passengers through the historic district ever since. From the Cripple Creek Midland Depot to the Narrow Gauge locomotives, the Birmingham's have been preserving the history of the railroads.

The train runs on a 2 ft. narrow-gauge track navigating a section of the original Midland Terminal Railway and the Florence and Cripple Creek Railroad. The 15-ton Iron Horse is the 0-4-0 type typical



of the early days of steam engines. It runs from Cripple Creek past the old Midland Terminal Wye, over a reconstructed train trestle, past a number of historic mines and ends at the abandoned Anaconda mining camp before returning to the Cripple Creek station. Railroad staff narrate the history of the region and tell tales of the miners who came to Cripple Creek and Victor searching for their fortunes in gold.

The four-mile tour lasts around 45 minutes round trip. The tour is open May 24, 2025 through the first weekend of October. Railroad and history buffs along with kids and families will enjoy the scenery along the trip.

The Hotel St. Nicholas stands as a remarkable testament to Cripple Creek's colorful past, rooted in the fervor of Colorado's gold rush. Originally constructed in 1898 by the Catholic Sisters of Mercy, the building served as Cripple Creek's first dedicated general hospital during the region's



booming gold mining era. At its peak, Cripple Creek was a bustling town, home to tens of thousands of miners seeking fortune in the hills.

In 1896, two devastating fires destroyed much of Cripple Creek, but the Sisters' original hospital survived, albeit narrowly. The first two floors housed patients, while the Sisters lived on the third floor, and the attic served as the orderly's quarters.

The Sisters of Mercy left Cripple Creek in 1924 after nearly three decades of service. The hospital was sold and operated pri-

vately by local doctors for several decades

A big attraction among hotel guests and residents alike is the Boiler Room Tavern. This pub, which offers food and drinks, is home to the original boiler plate of the hospital. It stands tall behind the bar, silver with a four leaf clover.

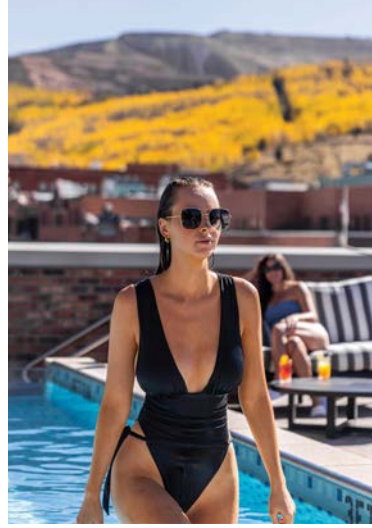
